**1. APOLOGIES**

- 1.1 Apologies were received from Cllrs Wilson and Mrs Woollons.

**2. DECLARATION OF MEMBERS' INTERESTS**

- 2.1 Cllr Mrs Humphrey declared a prejudicial interest over application LW/09/0865 on ascertaining details of the applicants, and immediately left the room and took no part in discussion and resolution over the matter.

**3. PLANNING APPLICATIONS RECEIVED**

- 3.1 The Chairman suspended Standing Orders and Mr Cooper stated that he considered that the front elevation of the proposal under consideration would blend in but added that there would be potential for an additional house to be added next to Nought, and referred to the congestion that sometimes occurs on this part of the road. The Chairman reconvened Standing Orders.
