1. APOLOGIES ACTION

- 1.1 Apologies were received from Cllrs Mrs Humphrey and Longhurst

3. PLANNING APPLICATIONS RECEIVED

- 3.1 Standing Orders were suspended and comments invited from members of the public present.
- 3.2 No comments were made in connection with the items due for consideration.

LW/08/1396 – 5 Farriers Place, Ringmer - Erection of a 2 storey extension to rear

- 3.4 It was agreed to recommend that permission be granted.

LW/08/1332 - Rear of South Norlington House, Bishops Lane - Erection of 3 bedroom house (resubmission of application LW/08/0855)

- 3.5 It had been resolved at last Meeting to oppose this application on a ground of inadequate access; however it was reported that an additional copy neighbour objection had been received on grounds of backland development, out of character, possible further loss of vegetation, and overlooking. It was agreed to note this further objection made.

LW/08/1364 - Rear of Old Lewes Library adjacent to Bus Station, East Street, Lewes - Erection of 2 semi-detached 3 bedroom houses and associated car parking

- 3.6 It was agreed to advise Lewes District Council that this Council does not consider that the planning application should be approved unless and until satisfactory permanent provision is made for an effectively sheltered bus stop in the immediate vicinity to serve the Ringmer-bound bus services.
