

Ringmer Break-in – 28th December 2011

This message relates to an incident which happened in Ringmer; however, even if this is not immediately in your area, we would like to encourage you to be aware of the importance of locking your home overnight and when out of the premises.

During the early hours of this morning 28th December 2011, an elderly lady in Ringmer woke to find a burglar in her home. The intruder had entered the property even though there were lights on within and was in the process of stealing the residents jewellery.

The resident confronted the intruder who demanded money and was pushed over, thankfully there were no serious injuries sustained.

This is an isolated incident but we would like to bring it to your attention for your awareness, to highlight the importance of securing your home against the opportunist thief.

If you do have elderly or vulnerable, friends, family or neighbours, please ask them to secure their homes at night.
