10/09/2009	Police Serial 745: 10/09/09 – Travellers moved in at The Broyle, Ringmer.	Police liaised with travellers and after negotiation moved to Bridie's Tan site on A27 without problems.
10/09/2009	Police Serial 1558: 10/09/09 – 19:40Hrs: 'Youths' smashing bottles at recycling depot in Anchor Field.	PCSO Attended – Area search – No youths or smashed glass found.
13/09/2009	Police Serial 922: 13/09/09 – 13:18Hrs: Suspicious van reported in Moore Lane.	PCSO Armstrong attended – Area Search – Van witnessed driving dangerously and at speed, male driving was a well known dangerous driver. PCSO Armstrong called for more units as van was unlikely to be insured etc. Van stopped in Potato Lane after driving through a maize field to avoid PCSO Armstrong. Male's van was seized, he was fined around £600 for no insurance, tax or MOT, numerous points were put on his licence and the DVLA are expected to take his full licence away with Sussex Police support. The male will also be charged with criminal damage to the maize field.
