

**Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places
Order 2009
Consultation – Ringmer**

PUBLIC NOTICE

Lewes District Council

Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001

Notice is hereby given that Lewes District Council proposes after expiry of the period mentioned below to make an Order designating certain public places within the District as places where the consumption of intoxicating liquor is prohibited.

Once the Order has been made, the police may require any person who is consuming intoxicating liquor in the designated public place to cease drinking and surrender up the intoxicated liquor or opened container for such liquor. Any person who fails to comply with such a requirement commits an offence.

Premises which hold a Premises Licence or a Club Premises Certificate authorising the supply of alcohol on the premises are excluded from the effect of the Order.

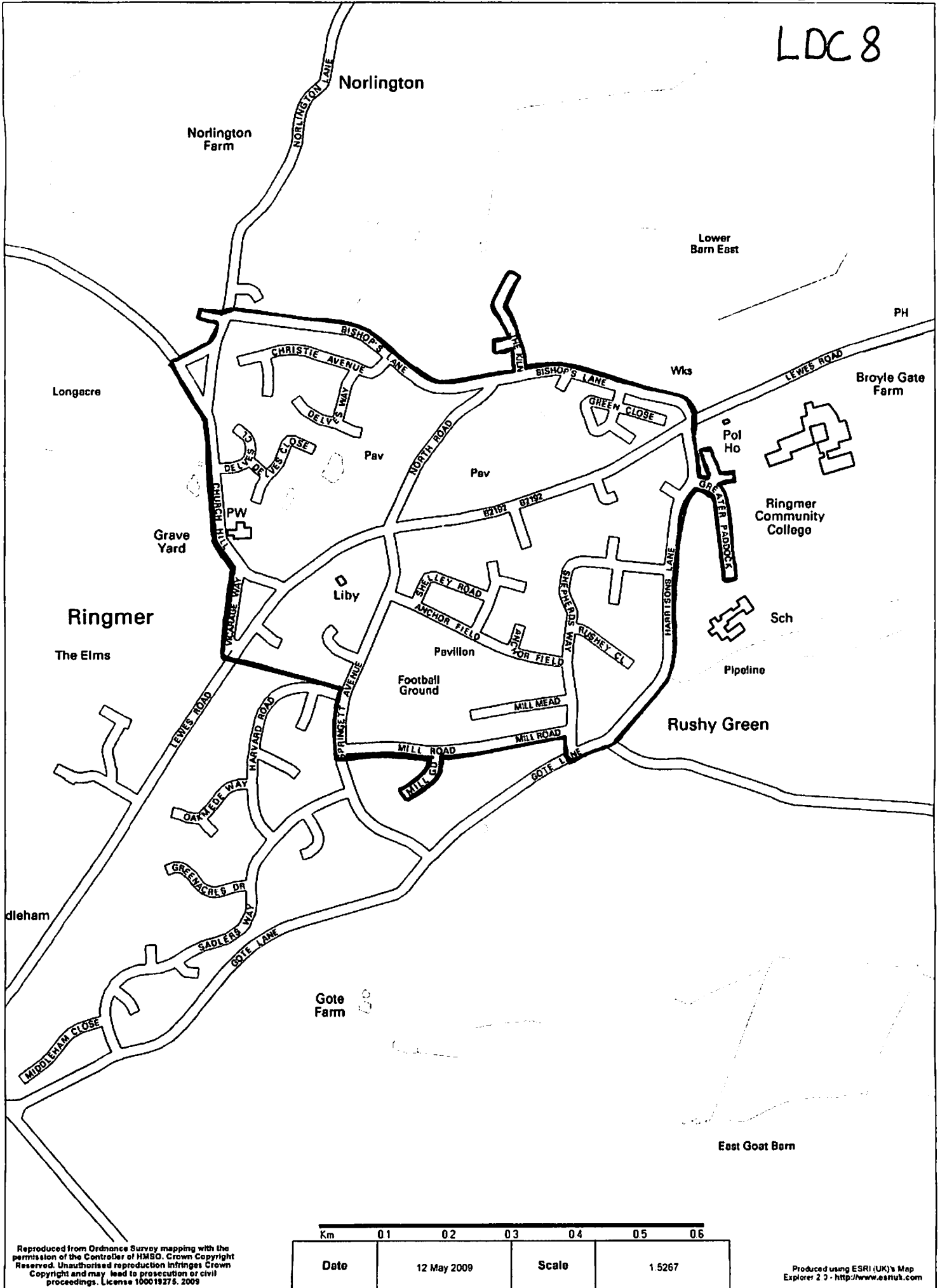
The designated public place is the public place within the area encompassed by the bold black line on the Plan LDC 8 attached to this notice.
