WITNESS APPEAL:

Between 1800Hrs on 30/09/09 and 0700Hrs on 01/10/09 a number of vehicles in the Ringmer area (mainly Craig Meadows, Harvard Road, Shelley Close and Fairlight Field) have had their tyres damaged by some type of bladed implement. 32 Reports regarding these vehicles have been logged.

It is now thought that this damage was caused over two nights and that the person behind it was either walking from Lewes in to the centre of Ringmer or vice versa. Sussex Police are looking for witnesses who may have seen this damage caused or may have noticed a suspicious person in the areas mentioned.
