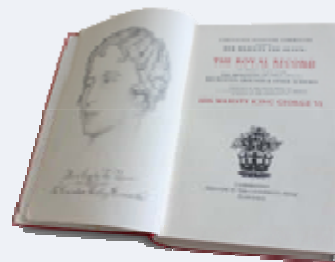

On the 10th October 2011, the Woodland Trust was honoured to see **HRH The Princess Royal** plant the first tree at the Burghley Diamond Wood. Set in the beautiful grounds Of Burghley House near Stamford, the tree will be one of over 23,000 which will include oak, ash, field maple, silver birch, hornbeam and small leaved lime.

We have secured our beautiful flagship Diamond Wood and we really need your help to purchase and plant this outstanding piece of land.



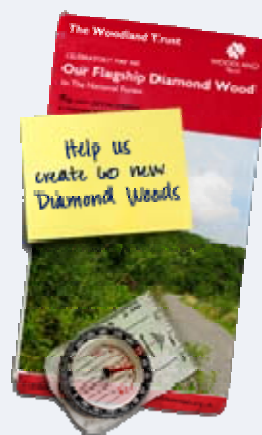
